Dear Christian Friends,

Greetings in the name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ! My name is Nancy Carew and I am a Global Ministries missionary assigned to the Liberia Annual Conference in West Africa as a teacher at the UMC Women's Training Center. I am thankful for your support which allows my mission service.

As we approach the end of the year and the end of the rainy season, we want to give thanks to God for granting us showers of blessings. There are parts in Africa that experience persistent famine due to drought, but we in Liberia are blessed with a good water table to allow ample growth of crops. In a country where seventy percent of the people depend upon subsistence farming, the ability to grow and market crops is essential to their livelihood. We also want to reflect on the goodness of God and how He has used us as instruments of his love, and for his unmerited grace in this part of his vineyard.

I am happy to report that the new dormitory was dedicated this year and we are now in the furnishing stage. We still need more beds, tables, chairs, bed sheets, towels, cooking utensils, etc. Some of the delegates attending this year's women's conference stayed in the dormitory. At the end of each day, they were able to fellowship together and prepare for the following day. We have also been able to teach some of our classes in the dormitory. The women and the young adult women continue to take advantage of our empowerment programs and other resources at the training center, to help improve their lives.
